HEATING AND COOLING EFFICIENCY

- Schedule annual checkups for your heating and cooling systems to keep them running efficiently.
- Regularly vacuum vents to remove dust.
- Plant trees or place container plants near windows for natural shade.
- Track your electric usage with OUC's Usage Dashboard.
- Adjust ceiling fan direction seasonally to improve air circulation.

THERMOSTAT AND APPLIANCE TIPS

- Set your thermostat to 78°F or higher for cooling, and 68°F or lower for heating.
- Conserve energy by running full loads in the dishwasher and washer.



- Clean your dryer vent regularly to enhance efficiency and prevent fires.
- Ensure your water heater is set to 120°F or lower.

WINDOW AND LIGHTING TIPS

- Use shades or blinds to control sunlight based on the season.
- Upgrade to a heat pump with a 15 SEER rating or higher to reduce heating and cooling costs.

ROUTINE MAINTENANCE

- Change A/C filters monthly for efficient airflow.
- Replace incandescent bulbs with energy-efficient LEDs.
- Wash clothes in cold water to save energy.
- Unplug unused electronics or use smart thermostats for better control.

Payment Changes



Starting January 1, 2025, cash and drop box payments will no longer be accepted at St. Cloud City Hall. Customers may make a utility payment with a credit/debit card in the walk-in center.
