OUC and SALT Outreach, Inc. recently unveiled a solar-powered trailer that will provide energy efficient showers to homeless citizens around Orlando. The trailer boasts four bathrooms – each containing a shower, toilet and sink.

OUC sponsored a solar retrofit of the trailer which, until now, required connection to a power source. Four new solar panels are able to provide approximately 60 showers during one charge.

“As the hometown utility, we’re always seeking ways to combine our commitment to renewables with our community outreach,” said **Jenise Osani**, OUC Vice President of Marketing & New Products. “This partnership with SALT allows us to spread

the message of clean energy while helping our neighbors work to end their cycle of homelessness.”

According to SALT Outreach, many of our area’s homeless citizens have to wait as long as three months between showers.

A shower, along with clean clothes, identification, haircuts, eye glasses, and more, are crucial to seek and maintain employment and eventually find permanent housing.

OUC-LED EV CONVOY STRESSES ELECTRIC TRANSPORTATION WITH LEGISLATURE

As a show of support for zero-emission transportation, OUC executives and local elected, business and community leaders traveled to Tallahassee in a convoy of electric vehicles for the opening day of the 2020 Florida Legislative Session. The convoy of eight rented black Tesla Model S 75Ds and an OUC Chevrolet Bolt made the 520-mile roundtrip. OUC’s team sought to impress on state officials and lawmakers the need for EV-friendly policies that would support construction of EV charging infrastructure throughout Florida, electrification of buses and diesel-emission reduction.

SPRING PLANTING TIPS FROM OUC VEGETATION MANAGEMENT

- ✓ Call **811** before you dig. OUC will mark your underground utility lines for free.
- ✓ Visualize your planting area beforehand and allow enough space for plants to grow to full potential.
- ✓ Select the right plant by considering the amount of sunlight, soil conditions, nearest water source and location above or below utility lines.
- ✓ Trees planted within 20 feet of an overhead utility line should have a maximum height of 20 feet or less.
- ✓ Use a rain barrel to water your plants. OUC even offers a rebate for a new water cistern. Learn more at OUC.com/rebates.
