- Update Contact Information Make sure we have your current phone number and email address. This makes it easier to use our automated phone system.
- Register for Outage Text Alerts Report an outage and get updates via text, voice or email. Alerts are available in English and Spanish! Text REG to 69682 to register or visit OUC.com/alerts.
- View OUC's Interactive Outage Map –
 Get real-time outage information, including

- locations and estimated restoration times. Visit **OUC.com/Outage**.
- Request Tree Trimming Let us know if tree limbs appear to interfere with power lines.
- Download OUC's Tropical Weather Guide –

- 1 Adjust your thermostat to 78 degrees for optimal cooling without excessive energy usage.
- 780 COOL AT: 78°
- Consider installing a smart thermostat to manage your air conditioning, potentially saving up to 10% on cooling expenses when you're away.
- 3 Replace your air conditioning filter monthly to ensure efficient operation.

- 4 Keep blinds, shades, and curtains closed during the day, especially on windows facing east or west, to block out heat from the sun.
- Improve insulation by caulking, adding weather stripping, and sealing outlets and switches to prevent hot air from entering and cool air from escaping.
- 6 Use ceiling fans strategically by running them only when rooms are occupied and ensuring they rotate counterclockwise to create a cooling breeze.
