Temporary traffic changes to occur on East Robinson Street from Rosalind Avenue to Summerlin Avenue

Crews will replace aging water main pipes

To provide you with the most dependable and resilient services and to accommodate Orlando's continued growth, OUC—The *Reliable One* is upgrading water main infrastructure in the East Robinson Street area of downtown Orlando from Broadway Avenue to North Mills Avenue.

This project will replace .50 miles of aging water main pipes and includes undergrounding existing overhead electric distribution lines between Broadway Avenue and Eola Drive. Additionally, existing underground electric lines between Rosalind Avenue and Broadway Avenue will be replaced.

Construction starts April 10 and will continue through December 2024. Most of the project work will be on East Robinson Street.

OUC's contractor, Schuller Contractors, Inc., will perform the installation. Typical work hours will be Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. The following street closures are anticipated from April 10 through the end of August.

- East Robinson Street will be closed in both directions from Broadway Avenue to North Eola Drive. Driveway access to businesses in this vicinity will be closed and alternate driveway entrances will be accessible.
- Eastbound lanes of East Robinson Street will be closed east of Rosalind Avenue to Broadway Avenue. Driveway access to 200 East Robinson Street will remain accessible. Hillman Avenue and Cathcart Avenue will be closed at East Robinson Street.
- Southbound North Eola Drive will be closed at East Robinson Street.
- Westbound lanes of East Robinson Street will be closed between North Eola Drive and Summerlin Avenue. Driveway access will be maintained on the south side of E Robinson Street in this vicinity.
